

ACCOMMODATIONS FOR THE DISABLED

Plans for new buildings and renovations or alterations of existing buildings will offer such design and accommodations as to make the newly constructed buildings and renovated or altered areas accessible to disabled persons. The board will require that construction plans for new buildings and renovations or alterations to existing buildings meet accessibility standards as specified in either the Uniform Federal Accessibility Standards (Appendix to 41 C.F.R. Part 101-119.6) or the Americans with Disabilities Act Accessibility Guidelines for Buildings and Facilities (Appendix A to 28 C.F.R. Part 36).
