

## **PUBLIC GIFTS**

The school board may accept gifts, grants, and bequests from individuals, estates, corporations, other governmental units, or similar organizations. However, these gifts must be free of any restriction contrary to law. Further, the board is not in any way compelled to accept any gift, and does so only at its own discretion.

The following points must be observed in accepting gifts to the school from individuals or organizations:

1. Request to make gift to school must be in writing to school board for approval.
2. A gift to the school must be paid for by the donor before delivery to the school.
3. Any gift to the school must be accompanied by a statement from the donor passing title to the school board.
4. Form Adm 138 is to be completed and signed by the donor, school board representative, and the principal.
